

The Romanian Association of Energy Auditors for Buildings is a professional body founded in 2004 by a number of pioneers struggling to enforce the energy performance certification of buildings and modernization of new and old stock of existing buildings in the country. The association has individual members, who are certified energy auditors for buildings, as well as associate members, which are companies acting in the field of construction materials, energy saving issues, environment protection actions, green energy promoting etc.

The main objectives of AAEC are:

- promoting the buildings energy auditor profession;
- promoting the intelligent solutions for using energy for decreasing of the energy consumption at the end users;
- informing and educating of end users to form an "energy saving oriented behavior";
- guiding the responsible factors to adopt the proper politics / programs in energy and environment fields

AAEC, together with the Ministry of Regional Development and Tourism, initiated two pilot projects for energy modernization of buildings having a symbol value:

One dormitory for students at the Technical University of Bucharest (UTCB). The goal was to let future experts to learn the whole process, either by watching, or by the in-cornor organized in the main hall of the university. This public building had the first energy performance certificate displayed outside the front door to increase the general public awareness on certification and energy saving measures.
